# BONNER HOMELESS TRANSITIONS (BHT) MEMBERSHIP Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

## Why should I join?

If you believe that every person deserves a roof over their head, you should join us. Many of us are just a major illness, job layoff, or car breakdown away from being homeless; we live paycheck-to-paycheck. We're all in this together.

#### What is expected of a member?

Members are expected to become advocates for the homeless, and for the work of BHT, by staying informed and sharing their knowledge with family and friends. Members are strongly encouraged to attend an annual meeting, normally in the fall, to review progress and elect a board of directors.

## Are there membership benefits?

Members can take satisfaction in knowing they are helping their neighbors find temporary and permanent housing for themselves and their children. Members know they are making a difference and changing lives. Members will receive updates to help them be effective advocates for BHT and the homeless.

### What else can I do?

Volunteer opportunities and ways to donate to BHT will be included in the monthly updates. Members can get involved as much as they want; from serving as volunteer staff or a member of the board of directors, to just participating in the annual meeting, to simply writing a check.
